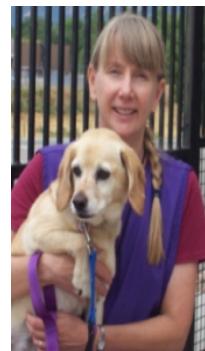

Volunteer Spotlight



This month our Volunteer Spotlight shines on longtime volunteer Leslie Irvine. Our clinic staff nominated Leslie for her dependability and her enthusiasm for veterinary medicine. Leslie takes initiative to work on prepping surgical packs and also jumps in to help monitor animals as they recover from anesthesia. Leslie even helps our vet techs prep animals for surgery. The clinic staff doesn't know what they would do without her, she has been in our clinic for years.

A Sociology Professor at CU, Leslie has impacted the Humane Society in many ways. Leslie has used our shelter for research, including writing a book called *If You Tame Me*. She cares a great deal about the bond between humans and animals and expresses this in her personal life through her dedication to the animals at HSBV. She has volunteered as a kennel assistant, foster volunteer, on our old Mobile Pet Adoption Unit, with special events, in ARF (Animal Rehabilitation Facilitators), and in the clinic. She serves in a leadership capacity by providing client communication training for our staff and helped develop follow up adoption surveys for Humane Society clients. You'll see Leslie walking dogs weekly; she always knows the scoop on every nose in the adoption center.

Here's what the clinic staff has to say about Leslie -- "Finally, Leslie is just great to work with. She is funny and gentle and brings so much compassion to the job. We should put the "spotlight" on Leslie!"
